

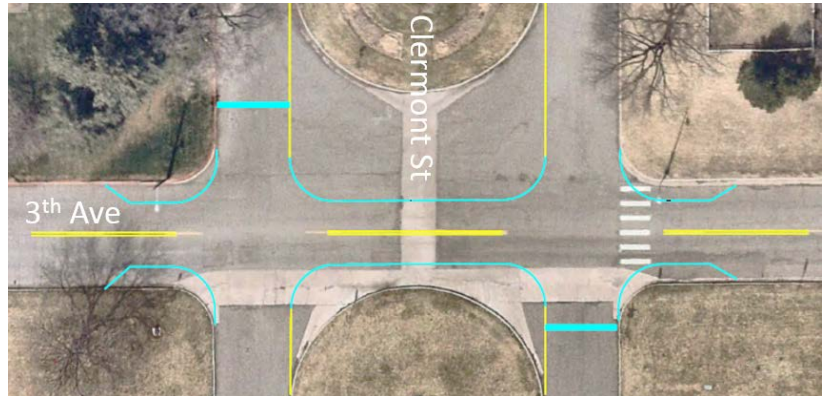
Neighborhood Transportation Project Notice

Denver Public Works is installing three transportation projects in the Hale and Hilltop neighborhoods in the Summer and Fall of 2018. These are the result of collaboration over the previous year with community members in the Colorado Boulevard Hospital District Transportation Sub-Committee and with the office of Councilwoman Mary Beth Susman. Where: 3rd Ave. & Clermont St.

What: Lane striping at intersection

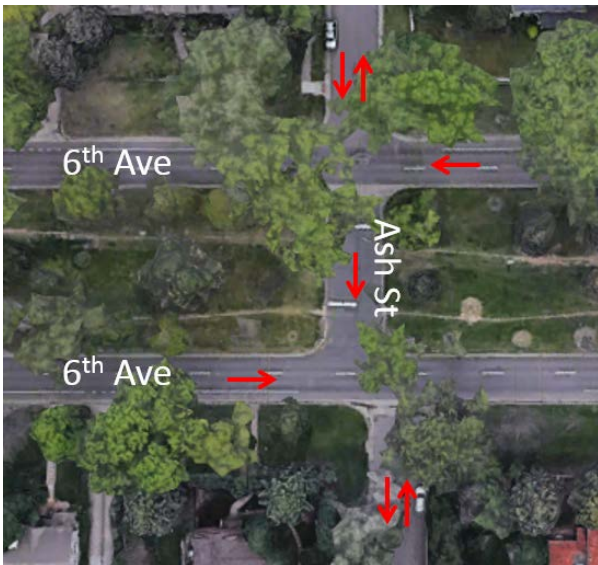
Purpose: To visually make the large intersection smaller, which can encourage more predictable and slower vehicle movements.



Where: 6th Ave. & Ash St.

What: Convert the portion of Ash Street at the 6th Ave. Parkway to one-way southbound

Purpose: To align vehicle circulation with development plans north of 8th Ave.



Where: 7th Ave. & Ash St.

What: Neighborhood traffic circle. The circle is made of temporary curbing. The project includes warning signage. Vehicles travel around the circle to the right.

Purpose: To slow vehicle speeds to align with the future 7th Ave. neighborhood bikeway and development plans north of 8th Ave.
